



## COMMUNICATIONS CHAIR

### Examples of Tasks:

- Attend Slow Food TV eventS, take photographs, interview attendees and write a synopsis for website
- Interview a local chef for a short profile
- Write a dispatch on a new farm stand at the market
- Submit recipes from locals or other inspiration for inclusion in e-newsletter
- Draft verbiage for Slow Food TV event invitations
- Write a feature on a seasonal fruit or vegetable each quarter/season
- Summarize new efforts with Slow Food International, Slow Food USA or Slow Food Urban TV

### Responsibilities:

- Suggest stories or events for e-newsletter and website
- Keep Committee chair informed of story progress
- Submit stories by agreed upon deadlines
- Attend regularly scheduled Committee meetings

### Qualities:

- Good, clear writer, able to tell a story succinctly and with colorful details
- Open to constructive editing
- Photography skills and/or access to digital camera
- Curious, creative and willing to suggest story ideas
- Able to collaborate well with the other members of the committee
- A good communication committee member likes being the one to keep their friends up to date on new producers they found at their favorite farmers market or the fact that the first organic peaches of the season are at the store.

### Time Commitment:

- Commit to one Community Council general meeting per month, plus additional hours or meetings needed for individual committees and tasks
- There will be an e-newsletter once a quarter, with monthly membership updates. (1-news letter each quarter & a monthly 1 paragraph up date to members- keeping them in the loop, which will come from any monthly socials, board meetings or events we hold).
